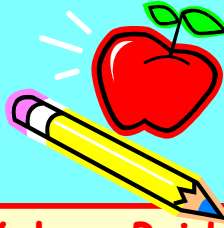

Butter Braid Fundraiser

My thoughts:

- I hope to conduct only one school fundraiser for the entire year. **So please support our Butter Braid fundraiser!!!**
- A school fundraiser is separate from PTO fundraisers.
- I believe that one school fundraiser faithfully supported by the students, parents, & community will bring in more funds than 3-5 fundraisers. This has been true for the last six years of Butter Braid fundraisers.
- If one school fund raiser does not bring in the anticipated funds, a second fundraiser may be required.

Butter Braid Fundraiser

Incentives:

- Every student who sells **10** or more Butter Braids will attend an inflatables party at the school in which concessions will be sold. Must sell **15** or more for two siblings and **20** or more for three siblings to qualify for inflatables party.
- The top 3 sellers for the school will receive in order a \$150, \$100, & \$75 gift card to Toys-R-Us.

Central Office Notice

In compliance with the requirements of the Every Students Succeeds Act, we would like to inform you that you may request information about the professional qualifications of your student's teacher(s) and/or paraprofessional(s). The following information may be requested:

Whether the student's teacher—

- has met State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;
- is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived; and
- is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher.
- Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.
